

### FIGURATIVE PLAN

Exhibiting a Birds Eye View of the River St. Lawrence and its principal tributary Streams from Kingston in Upper Canada to Ancie Blanc Sablon on the Labrador Coast near the Eastern Extremity of the Province of Lower Canada a distance of upwards of 1200 Miles. Also the Seigniories and Townships &c in the said Province of Lower Canada. Principally intended to Elucidate Evidence given before a Committee of the Honorable House of Assembly for Internal Communications, in February 1825.

The late Division of the Province into Counties as by the Bill passed by the Legislative Council and House of Assembly at the last Session, and Revised for the Satisfaction of the Honorable Members, is proposed by dots of the Counties & Districts of the Committee of the Assembly for the Internal Communications. The Limits of Counties are thus Represented.

The marks show a line where County lines have been assigned in reference to Townships in different parts of Lower Canada, & in some parts of Upper Canada by the said Surveyor.
